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**Overview**

Forest Environmental Limited (FEL) continues to reduce the environmental footprint of its office and on-site activities.

The areas covered by this report are: - general; fuel use; transport; landfill; in-house suggestions.

**General**

The general KPIs used by FEL show the following changes from mid-2010 to mid-2011 (using National Statistics deflator)

**Fuel Use**

The total amount of diesel used by FEL in 2011 has fallen by 4 per cent since 2010 against the company target of 2.5 per cent.

Our electricity consumption in 2011 represented a reduction in consumption of 1 per cent since 2010 against the company target of 2.5 per cent.

**Transport**

As a part of our ongoing programme to reduce energy use and associated greenhouse gases, the company continues to focus on key areas for improvements in efficiency.

The company has invested in a completely new van fleet in the summer.

**Landfill**

Asbestos waste disposal was concentrated with only two landfill operators. This resulted in efficiency savings that mitigated (in part) landfill costs.

**Materials**

Savings in timber purchasing due to revised methods of work allowed FEL to 'buck the trend' of material price upswing of this year.

**In-House Suggestions**

Two suggestions from site operatives made significant changes to method of working and environmental sustainability.
